

Coeliac Disease

Coeliac disease is a very common pathology caused by gluten intolerance. It is a **chronic autoimmune disease** that requires the sufferer to follow a strict gluten-free diet for their entire life.

Clinical laboratory tests are essential to make a diagnosis of **Coeliac disease**. If these tests are positive, the next step is a **Gastroenterological Examination** to establish whether to carry out a **Duodenal Biopsy**, i.e. the examination of tissue taken from the small intestine. The diagnostic procedure for the diagnosis of Coeliac disease must be assessed and requested by the Gastroenterologist.
